4.1.2. Workshop, held 2 July 2015

A very successful workshop was held on the 2nd July 2015, hosted at the National Library of South Africa.

After registration we received welcome from Dr. Eddy Maepa, Executive Director (Core Programmes) NLSA. Mrs. Roselle Jansen van Vuuren (Chairperson ILLIG) shared the Draft Southern African Code of Best Practice. The Code is to be used in Interlending departments. The aim is to improve efficiency by providing standard procedures for Interlibrary loans and Document Supply.

Mr Freeman Zulu (UNISA) gave an introduction on the Challenges and Tricks of the Trade. Groups were formed and the delegates had the opportunity to share some of their challenges that they deal with everyday in Interlending, as well as sharing the tricks of the trade that works for them.

We were very delighted to have a surprise visit from the LIASA Exco members during the Workshop.

Ms. Annamarie Goosen (LIASA Manager) did a presentation on LIASA as a Professional Body. She also gave a very thorough explanation of what LIASA is, what it stands for and what the benefits are when you become a member. The workshop ended on a high note when paid up members of LIASA each received a “LIASA proudly ILLIG” mug presented to them by the LIASA President, Mrs. Segametsi Molawa.
